

# *Welcome to the Temora Adventure*

## *9 - 12 March 2019*

*Unfortunately these rally instructions have needed to be done from maps and my memory, so it could be interesting. May I suggest you also keep an eye on the road signs that will indicate our destination.*

*Have you changed your watch to NSW time ?????*

*We are now working on Day Light Saving time.*

*Tonight our first evening in Temora, we will be joined by members of the Temora Antique Car Club at the Caravan Park*

*Some of the club members will be joining us on our tours, each day.*

*So I thought a self-catered, BBQ, for would be a good idea,*

*Apparently there is a Camp Kitchen available for us to use.*

*Not sure how many visitors there will be, but that doesn't matter.*

*Let's say at about 5pm we gather at the  
Camp kitchen for Nibbles*

*I'll organize some nibbles*

*BYO Drinks - food for dinner*

*Maybe a chair - as I haven't seen the kitchen  
I'm not sure what you will need.*

**9<sup>th</sup> March          Saturday          Let's explore Coolamon**  
**departing approx. 8.30am - if you can fit a chair/stool in you may need it later in the day.**

1. Depart our home base, travel along Tenefts Street and turn **RIGHT** into Airport Street & continue
  2. Cross railway line and continue **straight ahead** into Kitchener Road turn **RIGHT** into Hoskins St
  3. Hoskins Street is the main street in town, so **drive straight through**, cross the railway line.  
Pass the Information Centre on your **LEFT** continue towards Junee.
  4. Approx 11 ks from Temora you will need to turn **RIGHT** into Coolamon Road Follow the asphalt road.
  5. Follow this road for quite a few kilometers until you reach a “+” the road ahead is dirt stay on the bitumen turn **LEFT** it is a sharp turn, stay on the bitumen and continue into Coolamon.  
This should bring you to the top end of Coolamon. **Cowabbie Street**
  6. This is where you will find the **Info Centre and the Fire Fighting Memorabilia museum 10am - 4pm**. May I suggest you park somewhere in town and wander the shops. Remember the main shops will close at lunch time, though I've been there in the afternoon and the second hand shop / gift shop was open.
  7. You will find the **Cheese Factory** at the bottom end of **the Cowabbie Street 10am-5pm**
  8. The day is yours but may **I suggest we depart for home base no later than approx. 1pm assembling at the Info Centre at the top of the hill.**
- We have been invited to afternoon tea in the village of Ariaiah Park by one of the families, who are members of the Temora Antique Car Club.*
9. We will still assemble at the Information Centre at the top of Cowabbie Street. From there we will take the road to Ardlethan.
  10. Leave Coolamon on the road to Ardlethan and go about 12km along that road, then turn to the **RIGHT** onto the Mary Gilmore Road, to Ariaiah Park. At the '**T**' intersection with the Burley Griffin Way turn **RIGHT**. Take the **second LEFT** turn onto the continuation of the Mary Gilmore Road and the village centre is less than one km down the road.
  11. About ½ kilometer further on, turn **LEFT** and drive through the village of Ariaiah Park – our destination is **21 George Street, Ariaiah Park** our hosts are **Kevin & Siggys Colwill**. **While on the Mary Gilmore Way travel to the village. At the intersection where the Cenetaph is located turn right into George St., Kevin and Siggys place is on the corner with Colwills Lane (No 21 George St). Apparently they have a large grass area please park there.**  
This is a very pretty village and well worth an inspection. There is a coffee shop, pub, and SPAR grocery shop. Then retrace your drive back to the Burley Griffin Way, turn **LEFT** onto this road and that will bring us back into Temora.
  12. on arrival into Temora follow the main road – **LEFT** into Victoria Street cross railway lines, **LEFT** into Hoskins street.
  13. My Nanna's house was on the corner of Victoria & Twynam Street, on your left, brings back lots of memories.  
I've brought you this way so you can fill up with fuel, so you will be ready for tomorrow. There is a Woollies servo on the left and a Shell on the right as you travel towards our home base.
  14. **LEFT** into Tenefts Street. Welcome home. We made it. **Day 1** done and dusted.

**10<sup>th</sup> March Sunday**

**Let's explore Junee**

**departing approx. 8.30am**

1. Depart our home base, travel along Tenefts Street and turn **RIGHT** into Airport Street and continue
2. Cross railway line and continue **straight ahead** into Kitchener Road turn **RIGHT** into Hoskins Street
3. Hoskins Street is the main street in town, so drive **straight through**, cross the railway line.

Pass the Information Centre on your left continue towards Junee.

4. Approx 11 ks from Temora, you will need to turn **RIGHT** into Coolamon Road same as yesterday.
5. Follow the road, at one stage you will follow the road around to the left, remain on the bitumen. You will soon pass a farm on the left which is a family farm 'Georgieporgie'.
6. About a further 9ks along at the top of a hill you will turn **LEFT** sign post to "Marrar" Old Wagga Road.
7. Then about 10ks further along, the road splits and we take the **LEFT** more narrow road onto Murrulebale Road though it is still bitumen, but narrow. This will bring us to the main "Goldfields Way" Highway B85.
8. On arrival at the "Goldfields Way" B85" from memory we cross the "Goldfields Way" and travel **straight** ahead towards Junee. Follow signs towards the **Licorice / Chocolate Factory 45 – 61 Lord Street - 9am – 4pm**.  
Thought we might start our day here with a look around and maybe a cuppa.
9. When you are ready you can follow the roads into town for a look around – or follow the roads that indicate the **Roundhouse - Railway Museum, 92 Harold Street - hours 10am – 3pm**. I travelled by train as a child to Sydney for holidays, in trains just like these, my visit here brings back so many memories.
10. The day is yours but **may I suggest we depart for home base no later than approx. 2pm assembling outside the RSL (main street in town)**.
11. Our return journey, I suggest you follow the signs for Temora.
12. You will arrive at the "Goldfields Way" and turn **RIGHT** there – "**Temora**" sign  
This time I thought we might continue along this road travelling directly back to base.
13. you will pass the Info Centre on you right as you arrive in town, continue.
14. Cross the railway lines and continue once again, this becomes Hoskins Street, I suggest you fill the car with fuel, to be ready for tomorrow. Remember **LEFT** into Kitchener Road, cross railway lines and **RIGHT** into Airport Street
15. **LEFT** into Tenefts Street. Welcome home. We made it. **Day 2** done and dusted.

**11<sup>th</sup> March      Monday      Let's explore Cootamundra  
Departing approx. 8.30am**

**This is the only day with a few minor hills, some may wish to travel modern.**

1. Depart our home base, travel along Tenefts Street and turn **RIGHT** into Airport Street and continue
2. Cross railway line and continue **straight ahead** into Kitchener Road, turn **RIGHT** into Hoskins Street
3. Hoskins Street is the main street in town, so drive **straight through**, Just before the railway line, we veer **LEFT** into Old Cootamundra Road Cross the railway lines and continue along Old Cootamundra Road. Continue along this road, for quite a few kilometers, you will eventually come to a **"T"** turn **RIGHT** here.
4. Follow the road into town, following signs towards **"The Captains' Walk Park"** thought we might have morning tea here.
5. After our cuppa and a walk through the park, thought you may like wander the town. There are street signs to indicate how to get to the **Sir. Donald Bradman Museum, 87 Adam Street.**
6. The day is yours but **may I suggest we depart for home base no later than approx. 2pm Assembling at the Information Centre**, once again there are street signs to get you there.
7. we are now heading for Temora but I thought we might travel through Stockinbingal follow road signs.
8. you will come to a **"T"** **"Burley Griffin Way"** where you turn **LEFT** and continue into Temora. Continue down the hill and turn **RIGHT** into Hoskins Street.
9. Once again may I suggest you fill up with fuel, though, tomorrow we will be exploring Temora and possibly the local lake.
15. **LEFT** into Tenefts Street. Welcome home. We made it. **Day 3** done and dusted.

**12<sup>th</sup> March      Tuesday      Let's explore Temora  
departing approx. 9.30am**

1. Depart our home base, travel along Tenefts Street and turn **RIGHT** into Airport Street and continue
2. Cross railway line and continue **straight ahead** into Kitchener Road, turn **RIGHT** into Hoskins Street
3. Hoskins Street is the main street in town, so drive **straight through**, cross the railway line.
4. The Information Centre on your **LEFT**. Thought we would start here, may I suggest you purchase your passes into the **Rural Museum 9.30am – 5pm** and the **Air Museum 10am – 4 pm** from here, as it will be cheaper than paying at the various places.
5. To inspect some early Holdens – our host will be at Rhonda's cousin, Bill Cross workshop is at **120 Crowley Street**, head towards the train station. I suggest we assemble at Bills place at **11.30am** only about 10 cars so we will have lunch after our inspection.
6. After lunch may I suggest you visit the Air Museum at your leisure, this is beside the Caravan Park where we are staying.

You could possibly prepare for your move to Bright tomorrow.

7. Welcome home. We made it. **Day 4** done and dusted.

**PS: Thought we might drive into the RSL for dinner tonight, our last night in town.**
